

AGM Report 2002/2003

The Chairman highlighted the main achievements of the Branch in 2002/2003. These included:

- Eight excellent lecture meetings, including a special Christmas Lecture. These lectures are accredited under the CPD scheme with certificates provided at each meeting for members.
- An annual visit; this year to the BMW factory at Oxford
- Two successful “Meet the Committee” evenings, which provided an informal opportunity to chat both with the committee and to other members
- The current status of the Oxfordshire Schools Web Design Competition, arranged by the Web sub-committee
- The branch Web Site – which continues to develop as a useful resource for Oxfordshire Members
- The committee calendar for 2002/2003 looked like:
 - 5 main committee meetings
 - 5 web sub-committee meetings
 - Attendance at the Branches Congress
 - Web Competition prize giving

A feedback form was also provided soliciting comments/views from the membership.

The Treasurer presented the accounts, and these were duly accepted and passed by the members present.

Judd Flogdell stood down from the committee due to an impending move out of the area. The remainder of existing committee all stood for re-election, and further nominations were solicited from the floor, although none were forthcoming at the meeting. The roles and responsibilities of the new committee would be decided at the next meeting after the AGM, scheduled for May 2003.
